The total take before costs was over \$1100

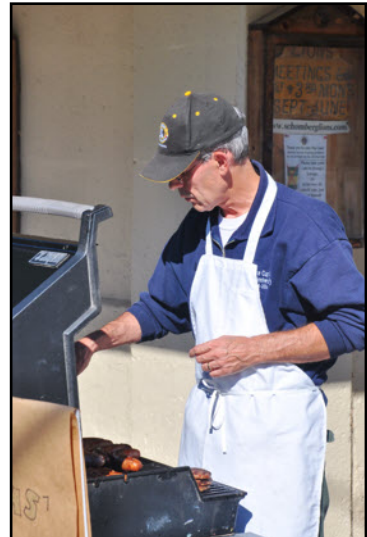
